## HEALTH PROTOCOL

OF FOREIGNERS ENTRY TO INDONESIA IN THE PANDEMIC OF COVID-19

As regulated on Article 40 of Law No 6 Year 2018 about Health Quarantine, in the case of someone refused to participate in the Health Quarantine, Health Quarantine Officer have the authority to issue a recommendation to Immigration Office for the purpose of deportation.

## INCOMING INDONESIAN(S)/ FOREIGNER(S)

are highly advised to bring a Health Certificate (HC) written in English which states Negative Result of PCR Test and must be issued by the health authority of country of departure within a maximum of 7 days prior to departure date.
